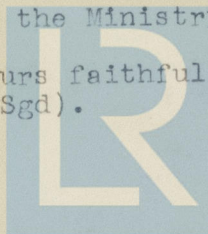
Dear Sir,

We are in receipt of your letters of the 26th ultimo concerning the m.s. "EMPIRE ALDER" ex "Pelikan" and m.s. "EMPIRE MOWDDACH" ex "Pontos" and beg to inform you that these vessels are intended for management by Messrs. Kaye, Son & Co. Ltd. (Jamaica Banana Producers S.S. Co. Ltd.) and all previous arrangements regarding management of these vessels has been cancelled.

In connection with survey of these vessels, Messrs. Kaye, Son & Co. Ltd., in a letter addressed to their Agents at this port state that vessels will require to be completed to the Society's class for hull and machinery (main, auxiliaries, refrigeration) and survey is being carried out with this in view. The plans as per our letter of the 12th ultimo were forwarded to you for approval with a view to vessels being classed with the Society, but would be glad if confirmation to this effect could be obtained direct from the Ministry, London.
