In referring to your yesterday's visit we send you herewith the general-arrangement plan SE 1 (1 copy for each ship) and the following plans (2 copies each) for approval.

- SK 1 Verkleidung des Ganges auf dem Hauptdeck
Spt. 49 - 95 BB und St. B.
Screen walls at the side of the alleyway on
1st deck section 49 - 95 port and starboard side.
- SK 2 Aussenhaut in der Poop
Side plating of poop
- SK 3 Poopdeck und Frontschott
poopdeck and poop front bulkhead
- SK 4 Backdeck
forecastle deck
- SK 5 Aussenhaut in der verlängerten Back
Side plating of lengthened fore-castle.
- SK 6 Dopplungen im 1 Deck im Bereich des Backfront-schottes
und der Luftkühler-Öffnungen.
Doubling plates on 1st deck in way of fore-castle end
bulkhead and air cooler openings.

We beg to remark that the plans SK 1, 2 and 3 belong to both ships, whereas the plans SK 4, 5 and 6 are only good for the "PELIKAN". Furthermore, we beg to remark that on the plan SK 4 the hatch size differs from that on the general plan SE 1 of the "PELIKAN", and we beg to discuss this arrangement once more with the Owners. We think the size to be sufficient, so that the hatch now sited in the 1st deck can be changed to the fore-castle deck without any alteration and the pillaring at the fore end of the hatch will center to the pillaring below.
