undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Representative of Messrs. Kaye Son & Co. Ltd., of London, attend on board single screw motor vessel "EMPIRE MONDDACH" of London, as she lay afloat at Hamburg on the 18th July 1947 for the purpose of ascertaining her condition with a view to a contemplated voyage under her own power from Hamburg to London U.K. in ballast.

vessel has been under survey in drydock and afloat at Hamburg since January 31st, 1946 with a view to classification with Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

Requisite surveys have been completed with the exception of Freeboard Measurement and Refrigerating Machinery and appliances.

Tests C 11 and C 11 (Comp.) have been partially completed and will be forwarded to London U.K. for completion.

Generation insulation remains to be completed in way of engine room pipes, hold tank top and No 2 hold, also in way of cooler fans.

To complete the survey of Refrigerating Machinery and appliances, the cooler require to be installed, the evaporator coils require to be cleaned out and being fitted to compressor rods. The whole of the Refrigerating Machinery appliances require to be tested under working conditions.

Electrical circuits installed in the crew's accommodation in the poop space not in accordance with Rule Requirements.

Stable used is such as was approved as a war time measure by Germanischer Lloyd and the appropriate German Government Department, but it is recommended the new installation be further examined and dealt with as found necessary on the vessel's arrival in U.K.

Main and Auxiliary Machinery, the steering gear, windlass and pumping equipment have all been examined under working conditions during a mooring and it is considered that this vessel is fit to proceed on a contemplated voyage from Hamburg to London in ballast, where it is stated all outstanding requirements will be attended to.
