The 1st. athwartship beam forward of the after end of the hatch has been moved forward 10 1/2" to suit a mechanical conveyor.

New covers, of 3 3/4" thick wood, have been fitted to take the increased span.

Please note with regard to the 1st. Entry Form:-

At No. I Hatch, due to the 1st. athwartship beam forward of the after end of the hatch having been moved forward 10 1/2" to suit a mechanical conveyor, new thicker wood covers have been fitted at the respective decks, to take the increased spans, as follows:-

3 3/4" thick at the Forecastle Deck;

and 3 1/4" thick at the Upper, 2nd. and 3rd. Decks.

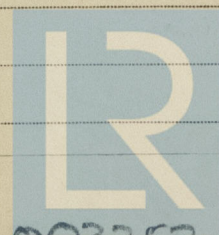
