Stewarts & Lloyds Ltd., Birmingham, attend at their Coomba Wood Tube Works on the 4th July, 1939 and subsequently at the Works of The Prothero Steel Tube, Co., Ltd., for the purpose of inspecting and testing 8 - 4.1/2" o.d. x 6G. x 18'0" Weldless Steel Tubes, for Deck Oil Fuel Pipe Line, made to the order of Messrs. Matheson & Co., Ltd., and intended for Hong Kong & Whampoa Dock, Indents No. 1198, Hull No. 829.

Tensile, expanding and flattening tests were carried out with satisfactory results as detailed below:-
