With reference to the case of the above named ship, which it is understood is now your property, it is noted from the Shipping Press that the vessel is apparently again in service.

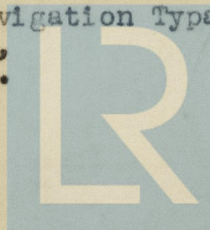
