Steamer "GLENCULLEN"

The Committee have today had before them the case of the above named ship mentioned in the Owners' letter forwarded by you here with your memorandum of the 1st instant.

In reply, the Owners should be informed that for the extension desired it will be necessary for the vessel to be seen in drydock before the end of July next, and for a General Examination to be held, to enable the Surveyors to satisfy themselves that the ship is in a fit condition for the period contemplated.

So far as the Load Line Certificate is concerned, this will expire on the 1st September next, and if a Load Line Survey is held in conjunction with the General Examination, a further Certificate valid to December, 1963, will be issued.
