I duly received your letter of the 16th ultimo enclosing photographic copy of the Helsingborg Surveyors' First Entry Report relating to the refrigerating appliances of the above named vessel for which classification with this Society is desired.

The particulars of the case were forwarded to the Surveyors on the east coast of the United States, and I am advised by the Baltimore Surveyors, who had her under survey for drydocking and tailshaft examination, that due to the difficulty in obtaining a supply of freon nothing could be done towards the completion of the Refrigerating Survey. The master requested postponement of this work until the vessel returns from her present voyage when he will communicate with the Surveyors at the port to which he returns.
