Outstanding Conditions of Class: SUBJECT to shell plate No.2 in 5th & 6th strakes below sheerstrake (p.s.f) being specially examined and dealt with as found necessary by the next drydocking and to a bower anchor and 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the earliest opportunity.

Nature of Present Survey: (Afloat ~~and in drydock~~)

Equipment - a bower anchor and 30 fathoms of c.c. supplied, but as this was salvaged equipment certificates were not available.

Recommendation:

SUBJECT to shell plate No.2 in 5th & 6th strakes below sheerstrake (p.s.f) being examined and dealt with as necessary by the next drydocking and to the weight of the bower anchor (supplied Ist.9,62) being ascertained at the earliest opportunity.
