With reference to the case of the s.s.

I find that through an error on the first entry  
report of this vessel the first entry certificate  
of classification was issued without the cargo battens  
being shown on the half sketch of midship section.

The certificate also stated that cargo battens  
werenot fitted.

have been reported as fitted with 2" close ceiling,  
and I shall therefore be glad if you will obtain  
the first entry certificate from the Owners and forward  
it to this office, when a fresh corrected certificate  
will be issued.
