Turbo-Electric Vessel "FRANCINE CLORE"

Reverting to your letter of the 9th and my reply of the 12th September last, I beg to acquaint you that the following items are outstanding for completion of the Special Survey of this vessel, viz:-

HULL Oil fuel bunkers to be tested;
vessel to be cut and strapped.

MACHINERY Examination of thrust bearing, main
propulsion motor bearings, main turbine
generator and bearings, main and auxiliary condensate pumps,
lube oil pumps, fuel oil service pumps, fuel oil
transfer pumps, bilge and ballast pumps, sanitary
pumps, main and auxiliary circulating pumps, fire
pumps; high potential test to be applied to the
main propulsion motor and generator and electrical
circuits and equipment to be examined and megger tested.

The vessel's Load Line Certificate will expire on the 30th September next, and I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for the requisite survey to be held for the renewal of this Certificate.

It will also be appreciated if you will kindly advise me what arrangements you have in mind as regards the completion of the Special Survey for full classification with this Society.
