The LONDON Surveyors report, 3,48, ship examined indrydock, m coated, and minor repairs effected.

The indented bottom plating, as above, examined and found dent meantime. The sternframe wastage examined and found to have dled somewhat. The wastage was cleaned out and sternframe built up W., and a zinc plate fitted in way. The Surveyor recommends this e be specially examined at the next drydocking.

IT IS SUBMITTED this ship is worthy to have her present ls maintained with docking date of 3,48, subject to indented bottom g (p & s.f.) being dealt with at the first convenient opportunity, rnframe (wasted) (E.W. 3,48) being examined at the next drydocking, o 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the first opportunity.
