Centre of Disc - 8'8" below top of statutory deck line.

Fresh Water
Allowance - $7\frac{1}{4}$ "

Winter Addition- 7"

The upper edge of the S.D.L. is level with the
intersection of the top of the composition on the
upper "F" deck with side.

The composition is $1\frac{1}{2}$ " thick above steel deck.
