With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the above named vessel, the Committee have now had before them the report of survey held at Cardiff last November and, as it is understood the vessel is now in service on the East Coast of Great Britain, the class has been amended to #100A1 "Fitted for pumping and carrying sand in bulk" "Coasting service within the Goodwin Sands and to Yarmouth".

As you are already aware a Special Survey became due on this vessel in November, 1960, and as a result of the Cardiff inspection the Committee have agreed to the Special Survey being deferred until some time before the end of February, 1962.
