Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

HATCH No. 1:

Half round moulding fitted at bottom edge of both side coamings. Cleats now spaced as per sketch below. Lashings provided for all hatch covers.

HATCH No. 2:

Lashings provided for all hatch covers. Ceiling in way of No. 2 hold, 3" thick and efficiently supported.

Hold pillar fitted each end of No. 2 hatchway.

Sounding pipes fitted in way of holds and peaks with doubling plates below.

Various holes in wood bulkheads plugged.

Lifeline fitted between deckhouse and forecastle.

Canvas cover supplied for ventilator to forward hold.

Closing appliances provided for air pipes not fitted with gauze.
