Sigmund Pumps Limited, attend their Works at Team Valley Trading Estate, Gateshead, on the 2nd June, 1956, for the purpose of examining and witnessing tests on one Fire Fighting Pump No. 609356 complete with Broom & Wade belt driven priming pump, ordered by Messrs. Mason & Burletson and intended for s.s. "KYLEE".

This pump, coupled to and driven by a "Petter" Diesel Engine No. 747102, Type AV2 10.6 H.P., 1600 R.P.M., was examined under working conditions and the following results were obtained :-
