Dear Sir:-

I duly received your letter of the 30th ultimo relative to the item of \$325.00 for New York Expenses, which appears in Montreal First Entry Report No.3089 on the steamer "FLEURDELIS", and with regard thereto I may say that the Surveyor was instructed to charge this amount pro rata against the three vessels building by Canadian Vickers, Ltd., viz., "FLEURDELIS", "PREVENTOR" and "SAUREL".

It appears that in addition to collecting the fees and expenses due to the Montreal Office for the "FLEURDELIS" and "PREVENTOR", Mr. Allan has also obtained payment of \$100.00 expenses on each vessel for the New York Account. However, instead of making the usual entries in his Returns for these amounts, he has forwarded drafts from the Montreal funds to this Office, and the payments are shown in the New York a/c 4a under date of the 26th November last.

The same thing applies in the case of the steamer "EMPIRE STATE", Montreal Report No.3077, the payment of the \$60.00 for New York expenses appearing in our a/c 4a under date of the 21st November, 1929.

The balance of \$125.00 due to this Office has been charged on the a/c recently rendered for the steamer "SAUREL".

I have explained to Mr. Allan the method which should be followed in crediting sums due to other ports, and perhaps you will be good enough to arrange for the amount of \$325.00, appearing in Montreal Report No.3089 on the steamer "FLEURDELIS", to be changed to \$100.00.


