Classification Surveys of Refrigerating
Plants.

I duly received your letter of the 10th instant and, in reply, have the pleasure to inform you that the necessary instructions are being forwarded to the Society's Surveyors at Singapore regarding the "CHARON," "GORGON," "ASPHALION," "IDOMENEUS" and "ORESTES." Your remarks respecting the "AJAX" are noted and accordingly I shall await your further instructions.

There are, however, several particulars relating to the above named vessels on which clarification would be appreciated, and I should be glad if you would kindly supply the following information:

(a) "IDOMENEUS" & "ORESTES."

It is believed the plans in the Society's possession do not show the present arrangement of the refrigerated cargo spaces, particularly with regard to the addition of an aftercastle, and the subdivision of No. 4 upper 'tween decks for the carriage of chilled beef. A plan showing the spaces as now fitted is therefore desired.

(b) "CHARON" & "GORGON."

The number, B.H.P. and output of the cooler fans, and the total length and outside diameter of each air cooler piping; also details of low temperature chambers, if fitted.

(c) "ASPHALION."

The total length and outside diameter of air cooler piping, the number, B.H.P. and output of cooler fans and also the total length and outside diameter of piping in each evaporator.
