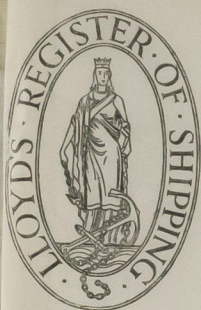

Owners Agents, Messrs. James Mackintosh & Co. Private Ltd., attend
on board the S.S. "STARLINE MERCHANT" 394 gross tons of Colombo,
on the 4th March 1958 whilst the vessel lay afloat at Kasara Basin
for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of damage
stated to have been sustained on the 8th February, 1958 caused by
the S.S. "SAGAR VEENA" while leaving the wharf at Kasara Basin,
making contact with the starboard side ford plating of the above
vessel.

For further particulars please see log books.

Upon examination the following damage was found and repairs
recommended without prejudice to the terms and conditions of
insurance.

FOUND

Ford, starboard bulwark plate
scored slightly. No.1 starboard
sheer-strake plate indented and
scored slightly between the 1st
and 3rd frames from ford.

RECOMMENDED

Indented sheer strake plate
(slight) to be faired in place,
paint work in way and at
scored starboard bulwark plate
to make good.

The foregoing recommendations were made with a view to
placing the hull in the same good and efficient condition as
before the alleged casualty occurred.

No repairs carried out at this time.
