The fees due on this vessel have been paid by the Builders and the certificates handed over to them.

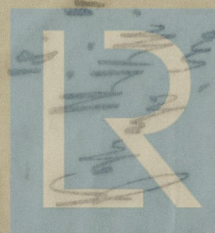
