The survey position is as follows:-

Special Survey due 1,60.
Donkey Boiler Survey due 6,58.
Screwshaft Survey due 6,59.
Last seen in drydock 7,57.

The ship's class is subject to the main engine exhaust gas manifold to No.6 cylinder being examined or renewed by 12,57, to the fresh water cooler water boxes and doors being renewed by 1,58, to the port aft generator being examined and dealt with as necessary in Holland at the end of her present voyage, also to the main engine No.4 piston being re-examined by the end of 8,58.

No part of the Special Survey has yet been held.
