Afterpeak tank examined internally and found space behind after peaktank 2 holes in trunk for rudder stock,  $\frac{1}{2}$ " doubling fitted over, floor O cracked in places, a doubling welded on, crack cut out and welded, frames No.1 loose on floor reriveted upon completion the repairs found satisfactory and afterwards tested as required by the Rules and found sound and tight.

Spaces above fore and after peak tanks examined and found good.

Bunkers examined internally and found in good condition, afterwards tested as required and found sound and tight.

Windlass and Steering machinery completely opened out, examined throughout with its connections and found in good condition, afterwards windlass and steering gear tested under working condition and found satisfactory.

Freeboard verified and found correct. Report form C11(d) attached herewith.

## Deep- and Forepeak tanks for cargo:

Examined and tested all lower hold and 'tweendeck deeptanks in hatches No.3 & No.4 intended for carrying cargo Palm oil in bulk and found in order. Doublebottomtanks under all lower hold deeptanks tested as required and found sound and tight, also heating coils in way of all deeptanks.

Examined and tested Forepeak tank intended for carrying Latex in bulk and found in order.
