Reference to the our Return of er Survey dated y, I shall be glad in the absence of l's name from your Rtns.5b, how the tands.	<p>Date:- 26th March, 1958.</p> <p>This ship was not under survey at this Port, or reported in our Return 5 in January, but the vessel was surveyed by the Shimonoseki Surveyors.</p> <p>A copy of this memorandum, therefore, has been forwarded to that Port for attention.</p> <p>3rd April, 1958.</p> <p>The vessel was surveyed at this Port on the 23 & 24 Dec.57 by Mr. F.A. Macfarlane for damage to equipment whilst moored to No.6 Buoy at Moji on 23 Dec. 57 & reported (Smk No.814). A recommendation was made that the Class of the vessel was subject to a spare bower anchor being supplied at the earliest opportunity & to enlarged end links being fitted to two lengths of cable starboard side by next drydocking.</p> <p><i>J.
