We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 1207 building by Messrs. Cantieri Riuniti dell'Adriatico - Monfalcone for Messrs. Standard Oil Company - New Jersey of 10390 Tons. Length 485'-0" Breadth 69'-9", Depth 37'-0" intended to be Classed Lloyd's 100 A1+ for Carrying Petroleum in Bulk

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connection therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:-
