Reverting to my letter of the 29th October the case of the above named ship has been under review here today on an appeal from the Owners, who now state that the vessel will proceed in ballast from Ceylon to Hong Kong where she should arrive about mid December, and will then be broken up.

In these circumstances, the Committee will not require the extensive examination previously suggested but will be prepared to authorise you to issue the necessary Certificates provided you are able to hold a survey appropriate to the issue of a Short Term Load Line Certificate for the voyage.

So far as the machinery is concerned there would not appear to be any action necessary on your part, unless evidence to the contrary is found.
