


Motorship "ETTRICKBANK"

Captain Scobie, the Chief Superintendent, has called in regard to our letter of the 29th October.

He states that the arrangements for this vessel have now been altered and that immediately after discharge of her present cargo, she is to be sent to Hong Kong to be scrapped.

The reason for the request for any extension beyond that previously granted is the delay which has been met in the discharge of the cargo in Ceylon. The vessel should be clear of cargo on 20th November, and the Owners desire a Load Line certificate for a voyage in ballast to Hong Kong where she should arrive before mid-December.

They hope that in these circumstances we shall be able to modify our requirements for a comprehensive General Examination.
