We would refer you to earlier correspondence in respect of the above vessel, in particular to our letter of the 18th May, 1962, subsequent to which her Special Survey was postponed for a further three months until the end of the present month.

However, earlier negotiations for her sale before this date were unexpectedly unsuccessful, and due to her having been seriously delayed in her recent voyage, she is presently lying at Colombo awaiting a berth to discharge a consignment of rice, and will not be free of cargo until next month.

We should, therefore, appreciate it if the Committee would consider allowing her class to be maintained for a further three months, that is until January, 1963, in order that she may eventually proceed towards the Far East, where we are negotiating her sale for scrap, and in which case we would promptly arrange for her to be suitably inspected by your Surveyor in Colombo.

We should be grateful for an early reply.
