m.v. "INCHANGA".

We have been advised that the above vessel lost her port anchor, along with two 15-fathom lengths and one 5-fathom length of chain cable, in Table Bay, Capetown, on the 7th June.

It is our intention to obtain replacements for this equipment from our m.v. "ETTRICKBANK", which latter vessel is to be disposed of as scrap towards the end of October, the two vessels concerned having the same equipment number.

We accordingly propose to land the spare anchor from the m.v. "ETTRICKBANK", along with the appropriate lengths of chain, at Durban where she is due the latter part of August and the m.v. "INCHANGA" will pick them up at a later date on her return southwards.

We trust that this will meet with your approval.
