This vessel carried out a General Examination last December at Calcutta postponing her Special Survey until July 1962, and it was our intention to dispose of her to new Owners before that date.

However, she is presently at Calcutta, where, due to the Pilots' strike at that port which is seriously delaying the arrival of other vessels of our fleet, we have no option but to berth her on our Indian/African Line, with the possibility that she will also have to load at Rangoon for West Africa, and consequently she will not be free of cargo until August.

In the circumstances we wish to apply for her class to be maintained for a further period of three months, until October next.

We presume it would not be necessary for the inspection to be carried out in drydock, but the Load Line Survey Certificate expires on 22nd July 1962, and this will require attention, and, if you are agreeable, we would attend to this promptly at Calcutta, where the vessel will shortly be free of her inward cargo.

An early reply would be appreciated.
