In reply to your letter of the 25th April I am pleased to inform you that the Committee are agreeable to your proposal to carry out a General Examination about July next with a view to the postponement of the Special Survey until July, 1962.

It is considered that the Continuous Survey of the machinery should be advanced at the time of the General Examination by the inspection of the following items, it being borne in mind that this will not complete the present Continuous Survey Cycle:-

Main Engine: Some side and centre bottom ends.
Some main bearings.

Auxiliaries: Pumping arrangements.
Steering machinery.
Fire extinguishing apparatus.
Electrical equipment.
