Requirements for assignment of class.

Inspection in drydock including Annual Survey and
examination of the following parts:-

Indents in shell plating (reported
in April, 1947)
Pitting in Engine Room Cofferdam (reported
in April, 1947)
Indents in B. strake, port side, frames
54 and 55 (reported in January, 1950)
Injection Box casing plates (reported
as being laminated in No. 5 Double
Bottom Tank in June, 1948)
Strake below sheer strake port No. 5
from forward reported to be set in
in June, 1948.
Shell plating to be drilled
Particulars of anchors and cables on
board to be obtained from the
Certificates

Items which can be credited to

Extended Special Survey, started in April, 1950.

Ranging of anchors and cables.

No. 8 R.B. $\mu + 1$ internal examination 2-51. *dlb*

Note.

In this case every effort should be made to advance
the Extended Special Survey as soon as possible as it will
be noted from page 4 of the Circular letter that it is
anticipated the major part of a Special Survey will be held
by the due date, reckoned in this instance as April, 1951,
although the Owners should not be pressed unduly on this
point, seeing that negotiations have only just been completed
and they probably do not anticipate a lengthy lay-up for
this ship next time she is docked.
