I am in receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant, enclosing a plan in duplicate, regarding the Owner's proposal to fit wing tanks in No.3 tween deck for the carriage of Latex etc., and I have to state that the scantlings and arrangements as shown will be approved in accordance with the British Corporation Rules and Regulations provided the work be carried out to the Surveyor's Satisfaction.

As the Owners do not intend to comply with the requirements for protection and damage as required for the notation "Carrying Latex in Tween Deck Deep Tanks" this notation will not be made in the Register Book. *drainage*

The duplicate plan is being retained for record.

It is noted that the work will probably be carried out at Singapore and I shall therefore be glad if you will obtain and forward to this Office a further copy of the plan for the use of the Surveyor when it is known definitely where the work is to be done.
