Capacity of Refrigerating Installation  
of Messrs. Alfred Holt's "P" class Ships.

I forward herewith a copy of a communication addressed to Messrs. Alfred Holt & Company on the 23rd ultimo, together with a copy of their reply of the 1st instant.

The refrigerating installations of the "PATROCLUS" and "PERSEUS" have already been classed as a result of surveys held at your port and at Glasgow, and the fees were evidently based on a capacity of more than 80,000 cubic feet.

In view of the fact that this capacity now appears to be in the region of 70,000 cubic feet, it is considered the sum of £8 should be returned to the Owners in each case and it will be appreciated if you will kindly make the necessary arrangements with them in the matter.

This may be done to your mutual convenience either by reducing the fees for the survey of the refrigerating machinery of the "PERSEUS", which is not reported yet to have come under survey, or in any other convenient manner, and I shall be obliged if in due course you will inform me of the action which has been taken.
