Referring to your letter of the 29th August last respecting 8 press boilers made by Kaldness Verksted A/S for the steamer "MAUDIE" we beg to inform you that we have today forwarded you under separate cover the Rpt. 5a. The boilers were placed onboard during the vessel's drydocking and repairs at Gothenburg in 1929.

The boilers are constructed as per plan approved 23rd May 1923 for pressboilers for s/s "SIR JAMES CLARK ROSS" but with thickness of shell plate $7/16$ " instead of $3/8$ " and top and bottom 20 and 17 m/m. respectively instead of 18 and 15 m/m as approved for "SIR JAMES CLARK ROSS"
