There was placed onboard 2 new press boilers in 1925 see oslo report No. 2850 and 4 press boilers in 1926, see Oslo report no. 2983, all constructed under survey and as per the above mentioned approved plan. ✓

Further there were placed onboard 8 press boilers in 1929 constructed under survey see attached copy of report dated 9th August 1929. These boilers were tested for a working pressure of 70 lbs. but have only been used for 60 lbs. ✓


