When, at a Special Survey, the Shell and Deck Plating is drilled the results must be reported on Report 8(Dr). Whenever Anchors or Chain Cables are replaced or retested the necessary particulars are to be given on Report 8(Eq) which is to be attached to this Report.

EXAMINATION AND REPAIRS AS PER RULE FOR General examination for postponement of Special Survey due 8/61. Ship 39 years old.

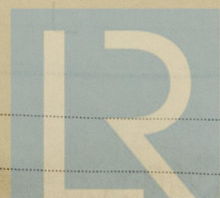
