With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the above named vessel, the Society's Surveyors at Nagasaki have informed me of your request for the issue of a Loadline Certificate to cover the period of May and June next, so as to complete the ship's present Time Charter commitments.

The case has been submitted to the Committee today as a similar extension of classification must be granted if authority is to be given to the Surveyors to issue the desired Loadline Certificate.

The Committee's attention has been drawn to the fact that the Special Survey which became due in April, 1957 was started at Nagasaki in July, 1957, when, among other items, the shell plating was drilled and a number of repairs effected, and in the circumstances they have agreed to the postponement desired, but wish me to impress upon you that no further extension beyond June will be contemplated.

For the issue of a new Loadline Certificate for this period, it will be necessary for you to hold a Loadline Renewal Survey, and if you will kindly let me know the port at which such an inspection can receive attention, the necessary instructions will be issued to the Surveyors concerned.
