Dear Sirs,

I beg to inform you that the machinery built by Messrs Richardsons Westgarth & Co Ld has now been fitted on board Messrs Sir J. Laing & Sons S.S. No 664, and the vessel is expected to leave here to-day for your Port.

To complete the installation the casing gear requires to be fitted to the main boiler safety valves, a 10" suction pipe has to be fitted to the bilge injection chest, the spare gear put on board and checked and the electric lighting installation completed.
