ANNUAL FREEBOARD SURVEY HELD 7th 10th 12th / 1 / 46

On examination of vessel it was noted that a Companionway existed on Top of Tonnage Hatch serving as an entrance to Gunners accommodation.

The Companionway is of steel efficiently constructed - Sill 10" above wood deck - opening 4'-8" x 2'-6" closed by double wood doors 1 1/4" thick operated from both sides.

It is recommended that present doors be replaced by doors of 2" in thickness or Companionway being dispensed with & opening in Tonnage Hatch permanently closed.
