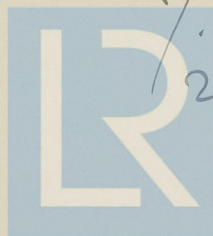
This vessel was converted during construction to an M.A.C. Tanker and the part of the electrical equipment fitted in connection with the flight deck was supervised and accepted by the Admiralty. The vessel was assigned a notation of "Carrying Oil Fuel in Bulk, F.P. above 150°P"

The Genoa Surveyor now reports the vessel having been reconverted to a normal tanker, the electrical equipment now being placed in accordance with the rules in that respect.

The C.S. has also been advanced; and the donkey boilers have been adapted for use with exhaust gases from the main engines.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible to remain as classed. Class is subject to the bedplates in way of the thrust entablature being examined by 10.46.

The machinery requirements for the notation "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk" have been complied with.
