"EMPIRE INOCUOL" on the 12th May 1946 for the purpose of witnessing the testing of two 4 tons S.W.L. derrick fitted to the main & miszen masts respectively, and two 2 tons S.W.L. derrick fitted to Sanson posts.

Proof loads of 5 and 2½ tons respectively have been applied by hoisting moveable weights with the derricks at an angle of 45° to the horizontal, with satisfactory results.

The blocks, wires and other parts of the cargo gear, correspond to the requirements of the British Factory Act.
