Dock & Engineering Co., Ltd., Hull on 11th September, 1951,
subsequently to examine and ascertain the general condition
of two Paxman 12 H.P.H. type engines, originally constructed under
supervision of the British Corporation Surveyors.

These engines which were completely reconditioned by the
makers in 1948 have been carefully maintained in storage since
then here from Makers' works, and are in good order, together
with adequate spares, the Makers' lists of which have been sighted.

No. 6 piston, cylinder, cover and valves, and connecting
rods in each engine have been stripped for examination and found
in good condition.

This examination is considered suitable in these circumstances
in view of the condition of the engines.

The engines are in good order & are considered suitable for installation in
any vessel.
