Motorship "CALGARIA"


At the request of the Society's Glasgow Office, I have to inform you that the class of this ship is subject to:-

1. Set in sheerstrake and bulwark plating in way port side aft in way of main mast.
2. Set in shell plates No. 3 and 4 in 5th strake below sheer starboard side from forward.
3. Set in sheerstrake plate No.5 etc port side from aft.
4. Bulwark plating etc. abreast No.4 hatchway starboard side.
5. Indented shell plating port and starboard in way of No.1 double bottom tank,
all being specially examined and dealt with as necessary, at the next drydocking.
6. Fifteen fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the earliest opportunity.
7. The starboard propeller being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking.
