With reference to your letter of the 18th November I have to inform you that the proposal to carry out a General examination in London in about 3 weeks time for postponement of the Special Survey until January, 1959, is in order.

The class of the vessel is subject to No.6 plate in 2nd and below sheer port side aft being dealt with by the next Special Survey.

There is an endorsement of certificate relating to keel plates No.7, 8 and 9 indented. Bottom plating port and starboard forward set up.

You will observe that the Screwshaft will become due for survey in March, 1958.

The Load Line Certificate will expire on the 1st January, 1959.
