Steamer "LJUBLJANA"

I have your letter of the 14th February and note that the Owners are now requesting deferment of the Special Survey of this ship until the end of September, subject to a General Examination in drydock.

As this will be a postponement of six months beyond the year of grace allowed by the Rules, the case has been reported to the Committee, and I am directed to say that they are not prepared to grant this extension on a General Examination.

As an alternative, I am to say that provided the ship is placed in drydock, opened up as for Special Survey, and the necessary repairs effected for the desired postponement of six months, the Committee will be agreeable to the assignment of a modified Special Survey notation.

I am to add that the limited service suggested by the Owners would have no influence on the above requirements.

So far as the machinery is concerned, a General Examination, together with the Boiler Survey, will be acceptable, and for the issue of a further Load Line certificate, a Load Line Renewal Survey should be held in conjunction with the hull inspection.

This letter confirms my cablegram to you today as per copy attached.
