In reply to your letter of the 23rd January I have to say that the Committee are agreeable to a General Examination being held at a Yugoslavian port next month, but consider that this should be held in drydock. In view of the age of the ship the period of postponement granted for the Special Survey will be determined by the condition of the ship as found and reported upon at the time of the General Examination.

I take this opportunity to point out that the Main Boiler and Screwshaft Surveys become due at the end of February and March 1962 respectively, and it is concluded that these inspections will be dealt with at the forthcoming drydocking.

I shall be glad to learn what arrangements are now proposed for the drydocking and General Examination to be held.
