As our Surveyor at Valparaiso had informed the Chief Engineer that the vessel could proceed on voyage as long as the new chain was on board as spare the Owners Representatives regret that they did not inform Mr. Wardle at Galveston re the renewal of the chain.

The Owners expect that the ship will reach Hong Kong at the end of the present month so that a further inspection with a view to the scrapping of the vessel is not further required.
