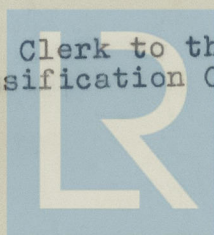
A notation of Drydocking 10.62 has been assigned and class has been continued subject to :-

- 1) Port exhaust gas economiser being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the end of February 1963.
- 2) Starboard exhaust gas economiser not to be used until repaired.
- 3) Port main engine scavenge pump piston rod being specially examined by the end of February 1963.
- 4) Repairs to port main engine camshaft drive chain being further examined by the end of December 1962.
