With reference to your letters of 4th February etc. regarding the above ship, the surveys of the hull and machinery were carried out at Rostock on 1st to 3rd May.

Fees totalling £ 245 + S.A. fees of £ 16 are proposed for the surveys and in connection with this I would mention that Mr. Dobson and myself left Szczecin on 1st May 10 a.m. and returned there on 4th May (4 p.m.) The expenses totalled £ 42.10 plus £ 3.15 for Gdansk cables + the cost of your cables. My expenses amount to £ 22.10.0 for which I am enclosing Expense Account. Kindly pay this amount into my account with the National Provincial Bank.

The Reports and Certificates for this case are enclosed. The Certificates have been made valid up to 20th June 1963 as the ship is loading a cargo of bagged cement and this may take several weeks depending on weather conditions.
