Motorship "IRINI'S LUCK"

I am in receipt of your letter of the 3rd April regarding the classification of this ship and in confirmation of our telephone conversation this morning, I have to acquaint you that in the special circumstances of the case, the Committee have now agreed to maintenance of class for one voyage from Rostock to Santandar for breaking up, subject to a satisfactory survey at Rostock in accordance with the requirements set forth in our letter of the 1st February last.

It is not possible to arrange for a Surveyor from London to attend the ship at Rostock, but it has been ascertained that subject to getting the necessary entry visa from the East German Authorities, arrangements can be made for one of the Society's Surveyors in Poland to attend the ship.

I shall therefore be glad if you will arrange for the master to cable the Society's Surveyors at Gdansk when the ship is expected to be ready for inspection.
